

CERTIFICATE concerning the distribution of working time for clinically or otherwise externally employed doctoral students

The Higher Education Ordinance (1993:100) indicates that third-cycle (doctoral) education is to be pursued at a rate of no less than 50 per cent of a full-time post (Chapter 5, Section 3a). When third-cycle education is pursued within the framework of employment for an employer other than the higher education institution, the employer/head of operations must guarantee that the doctoral student can devote 50 per cent of their working time to research (UFV 2012/841).

The actual period of study in third-cycle education must be equivalent to 4 years of full-time study for the Degree of Doctor, and 2 years of full-time study for the Degree of Licentiate.

Moreover, according to the guidelines at the Disciplinary Domain of Medicine and Pharmacy at Uppsala University, the employer/head of operations must guarantee the equivalent of at least three months of full-time for research per year. For a period of time equivalent to these three months, the doctoral student must not be scheduled to perform clinical or other similar work. For at least a further three months per year, the doctoral student must be assigned duties at a clinic or in other ordinary work that are relevant to the research project.

The three months that are free from scheduled clinical/ordinary duties should be provided in a block if the research project or third-cycle education requires this. The final organisation of research time is determined via consultations between the doctoral student, the supervisor and the employer/head of operations.

The responsibility for documenting the scope of scheduled clinical/ordinary duties (and being able thereby to show that 25% of research time per year has not been scheduled for such duties) rests with the unit/department/clinic at which the doctoral student is employed.

who is permanently employed at

will be guaranteed the equivalent of at least three months of full-time research, or an equivalent amount of time distributed in some other manner, per year.

During this time, the doctoral student will not be scheduled to perform clinical/ordinary work. This means that, including the above non-scheduled full-time periods, the doctoral student will be able to devote a total of 50% of working time to work directly related to the third-cycle education project.

By signing this, the employer/head of operations also certifies that they are aware of the doctoral student's individual study plan. This certificate concerns the organisation of working time, not funding.
